Supported by federal, state, and private grants, the purpose of Legal Aid's Low - Income Tax

Clinic is to provide FREE tax services to low-income and ESL persons.

Your information is protected by attorney-client privilege & confidentiality. We are not part of the IRS or any government agency.

If you received a notice from the IRS or the state tax department, or otherwise believe that you have a tax problem, we may be able to help!

YOU may qualify!

As many as 600,000 Hawaii residents may qualify for our ESL outreach program, which provides information to taxpayers who speak English as a second language.

As many as 400,000 Hawaii residents may qualify for our tax representation program, open to taxpayers whose income falls within 250% of federal poverty guidelines,

OUR SERVICES MAY INCLUDE:

- * Filing a petition or appearing in Tax Court
- * Filing an appeal
- * Assisting with an audit or audit reconsideration
- * Preparing a settlement offer to settle a tax debt
- * Asking for a stay in collections
- * Filing a past due return
- * Filing an amended return
- * Giving counsel and advice
- * Remove a tax debt by filing a past due tax return
- * Amend an improperly prepared return
- * Obtain audit reconsideration
- * Obtain Injured Spouse relief

Tax Outreach

Our Tax Outreach program provides information and education to ESL (English as a Second Language) speakers.

Workshops: We hold workshops on various topics. Although we strongly encourage ESL speakers to attend, anyone may come.

Consultation: Individual consultations on tax topics may be available to ESL speakers.

Information: We produce tax information materials on tax topics in English and other languages.
